Job Description

Graduate Student Teaching Assistants (GTAs) are full critical partners in the teaching and administration of Organismal Biology and Cellular & Molecular Biology classes. GTAs work with the primary course instructor and a team of Undergraduate Learning Assistants (UGLAs) to help students obtain a solid foundation in general biology through hands-on activities. Specific responsibilities for this GTA position is flexible but includes overseeing two laboratory sections, grading formal and informal laboratory reports and written examinations scripts, developing quizzes, overseeing waste disposal, laboratory preparation and grade administration. GTAs attend a weekly meeting with course instructor and UGLAs. All GTAs hold office hours each week in Holmes Hall.

Required Background

Applicants should have a broad background in biology, be comfortable with teaching common biological principles and techniques. In addition, the successful applicant will have good written and oral communication skills and be enthusiastic about biology, teaching and learning.
